Council Meeting Minutes
September 11, 2017

A regular monthly meeting of the Clarksville Village Council was held September 11, 2017 at the Clarksville Village Hall. President Amy Byers called the meeting to order at 7 pm.

Motion by B.Clark and supported by Mutschler to pay monthly bills totaling \$40,804.35. Motion passed.

Reports were read by Treasurer Barratt, Street Commissioner Reser, Sewer by B.Clark, and Clerk S.Clark.

Motion by B.Clark and supported by Mutschler to authorize Treasurer to transfer \$13,000.00 from General Fund to Local Street Account and open new bank account named "Saw Grant" with amount of match \$17,797.00. All in favor, motion passed.

Motion by Mutschler and supported by Sheldon to accept CL Trucking & Excavating LLC \$3,000.00 proposal for Catch Basin Repair at 3 locations. All in favor, motion passed.

Motion by Main and supported by B.Clark to renew the BEAUTIFY OUR BUSINESS COMMUNITY GRANT PROGRAM through October 31, 2018. All in favor, motion passed.

A second reading of Ordinance #71 Adopt Supplement S-3 to Code of Ordinances was read with no objections heard.
