Current/Future	Shared Service	Other Jurisdiction(s)	Service Description	Cost/Benefit
Current	Waste Water Treatment	Clarksville-Morrison Lake Sewer Authority	The Clarksville-Morrison Lake Sewer Authority provides waster water treatment and sewer lines for the Village of Clarksville, Boston and Campbell Townships.	The Village does not have to maintain any sewer lines or provide waste water treatment for any residence or business. This saves the Village any where from \$50,000 - \$100,000 annually.
Current	Fire Protection	Campbell Township	Campbell Township provides Fire & Rescues services for Campbell Township including the Village.	The Village does not have to provide its own Fire Protection.
Current	Snow Removal	Ionia County	Ionia County provides snow removal services for all roads within the Village.	This service saves the village \$25,000-\$50,000 annually.
Current	Building Code	Ionia County	Ionia County enforces the Building Code for the Village.	The Village does not have to hire a third party to provide this service. \$10,000 annually.
Current	Other Miscellaneous Services	Various Contractors	The Village routinely contracts out to provide other services such as street maintenance, engineering studies, tree removal, etc.	The Village does have any full time employees and thus does not have to provides medical or retirement benefits. This saves approximately \$45,000 annually.
Future	Recycling Program	Campbell Township	Campbell Township and Clarksville are teaming up to provide free recycling drop-off in 2012.	By splitting the cost, the Village will save \$2,000-\$3,000 annually.
