

Village of Clarksville
Planning Commission Minutes
August 21, 2014

A regular monthly meeting of the Clarksville Planning Commission was held on August 21, 2014, at the Clarksville Village Hall. Vice Chair Lu Baxter called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Planning Commissioners present - Vice Chair Lu Baxter, Jordan Burnie and Ex Officio Robbie Mutschler.
Absent - Chairperson Robert Blocher and Kerry McMillen.

Street Commissioner Pat Reser was also in attendance.

No public comment.

The minutes of the July 17, 2014 meeting were read and approved.

Robbie provided a report from Council:

- Council has decided to pursue a tree grant program in addition to the current program beginning next year
- Council is currently working on exploring some sidewalk repair in town

Pat shared with the Planning Commission a sample of what the new village welcome signs will look like. She also had some concerns over the tree study. She stated that state law allows the Village to maintain right-of-way trees. Lu and Jordan will research further and report findings at the next meeting.

Jordan provided a draft ordinance for an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance regarding dogs. Planning Commission will hold a Public Hearing at the September 18 Planning Commission meeting.

Nick Peterle wrote the Village Council suggesting the possibility of a dog park being established. Aside from the Village Hall and parking lot, the Village does have any other public properties for such a venture. A suitable location maybe the Campbell Township park, however that is within Campbell Township, not the Village of Clarksville.

The next Planning Commission meeting will be held September 18, 2014.
